Several health clinics in Ontario offer non-emergency health services specifically for international agricultural workers

- Most have translators and you can contact some of them directly through **WhatsApp** 
- For many of these services, you **do not need to present your OHIP** (green) card if you do not have it



GREEN CARD

In other areas, there are Urgent Care centres or walk-in clinics to help

- You may need help from your employer, a community contact, or a friend to assist you with visiting these clinics
- You will need your OHIP (green) card for these services, or you may be asked to pay a fee
- If you have recently applied for this card and don't have it yet, you can use the reference number on your application form



During the pandemic, all of these services may be offered over the phone or in person, they will clarify when you connect with them

You can also call Telehealth (day or night) to speak to a nurse for medical advice

If no one is available, CALL 9-1-1 from your phone. Translation services are available - say the language you need, ask for an "Ambulance," tell the operator what is wrong, give your address and location
